Project Profile

This finished, large format basin is part of a collection of stones executed for an up-scale residence in the Forest Park neighborhood. The stone for the main basin—an eight inch thick Iron Mountain slab—was hand-selected with the Landscape Designer and evaluated for final shape, form and basin specifications. The piece was then split and formed to the required parameters. A three inch diameter core was cut through the center of the stone to allow a high volume of water to enter and flow from the pool while minimizing the visible head. The basin was hand-carved to a depth of two inches at the center and honed to a zero taper at the outer edge. The lip was carefully ground and honed around the perimeter to allow for an even drop of water from all points of the circumference of the bowl. A natural inclusion in the stone was purposefully retained at one edge, where a cast bronze sparrow perches in immortal anticipation.
